

Extracting YouTube Videos

1. Download and install VLC Media player see <https://www.videolan.org/vlc/>
2. Open web browser (preferably Google Chrome)
3. Go to YouTube
4. Choose video you wish to download
5. Start video playing in YouTube and wait for all adverts to finish playing
6. Right click on video that is playing and then left click on "Copy Video URL"
7. Minimise browser window
8. Open VLC media player
9. Left click on "Media" tab at top left
10. Left click on "Convert/Save"
11. Left Click on "Network"
12. Right click on long rectangular box and then left click and choose "Paste"
13. Left click on options arrow to the left of the "Convert/Save" option at bottom of window
14. Left click on "Play"
15. The video will now start playing in VLC
16. Pause the video by left clicking on II button at bottom left of widow
17. Left click on "Tools" option top bar of window
18. Left click on "Codec Information" option
19. Right click on gobbledygook in bottom long rectangle
20. Choose "select all"
21. Right click on gobbledygook in bottom long rectangle
22. Choose "copy"
23. Close that window
24. Open new browser window – preferably Google Chrome
25. In the very top URL box (very top of screen) right click and choose paste
26. Press "enter"
27. The video will start playing
28. Right click on video and choose "save video as"
29. Choose destination folder to save video on your computer and give video a name
30. When complete you will have video on your computer
